SCF Arizona offers a 5 percent credit to policyholders that institute or already have a qualifying Drug-free and Alcohol-free Workplace Program.

To qualify, Arizona Revised Statutes require the policyholder to:

1. Provide information to the insurance provider, if requested, to confirm that a qualifying program has been established and is being maintained.
2. Comply with the alcohol and drug testing policy requirements in accordance with ARS § 23-493-04 and ARS § 23-961K. The statutes can be found at <http://www.azleg.state.az.us/ArizonaRevisedStatutes.asp?Title=23>
3. These state statutes require an employer:
 - a. Conduct drug testing of prospective employees (new hires).
 - b. Conduct drug and alcohol testing of an employee after the employee has been injured.
4. Allow the insurance provider access to the drug testing results.

The SCF Annual Drug and Alcohol Program Verification form is the only document an employer needs to complete. This form can be found on SCF Arizona's website, www.scfaz.com under the "Policyholder" tab.

Employers must renew the program and submit the verification form within 30-days of the policy renewal. The credit cannot be applied retrospectively.
